Deposit Contract

A deposit of \$300 guarantees a place on our wait list. It is our hope that the deposit process is stress free as you make a decision to purchase a puppy from us. Our goal is to answer any and all questions to help you with the process of adding a new member to your family. It is our sincere desire that you and your puppy have happy success to enjoy a life together. If at any time you have any concerns or questions please don't hesitate to reach out to us.

Deposits are generally non-refundable as they hold a place on the waitlist that someone else could have had. If your desired color and or gender isn't available for the litter you have placed your deposit down for (Unlikely) we will likely will have another upcoming litter within a reasonable amount of time so we encourage you to stick with us and be on the top of the list for the next litter

Balance for puppy is due only when you pick up your puppy or 48 hours before our flight Nanny brings your puppy to you. Our puppies are \$4500.

\$4200 balance in cash upon receiving your puppy.

Puppy choice: Choosing your puppy is based on where you are on the puppy deposit list. Being that there are different family dynamics and needs, it really comes down to which puppy is a good match for each family. As we begin Early Neurological Stimulation (ENS) we are able to see already the forming temperaments at a very early age. Not only are we with them 24/7 but we do formal temperament testing on each puppy. Puppies that are raised using our methods coupled with our careful selection of parent dogs ensures that each puppy will have solid predictable temperaments. Bernedoodles offer even temperaments based on breed alone. Raised properly by us and then followed up by puppy training done by you can give you confidence that your choice of puppy will be everything you were hoping for.

Puppies that are to be service dogs are automatically chosen first regardless of deposit order. This is not a common occurrence so no need to worry. We hope that you will be understanding of this

process. Puppies for special needs homes WILL NOT be chosen based on color or markings.

We reserve the right to have first pick of a puppy that shows promise for our breeding program. It is rare that we keep a puppy back but this needed to be included in the topic of puppy choice.

To encourage you: In 22 years of raising puppies I've never had a situation where a family wasn't happy with the puppy they have received. We've never had two families in competition over the same puppy. It always works out. Each puppy is beautiful as we have done our homework to be able to produce that look that everyone wants. What is the cutest puppy in the litter to someone is usually not the choice for someone else. Everyone has different tastes.

We do everything in our power to make sure each family is excitedly happy with their new puppy's looks and temperament.
